Summer 2007 Camp Schedules, Description and Costs

For High School:

June 15-19 Future Staff Camp – for those entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, or just graduated from high school. If you would like to gain the skills necessary for any kind of leadership – camp, small groups, youth work, etc. – as well as grow in your faith, this is the camp for you. \$125.00

June 26-July 2 High School Camp – (entering 9th-12th grade) All the fun and Christian content of regular camp, with a few extra treats such as polar bearing and a brunch. Come for a rest from the challenges and responsibilities of life, and be renewed and refreshed by the challenges presented at camp. \$150.00

For Those Entering 5th-8th Grade:

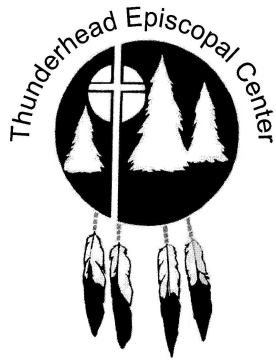
July 16-20 All Girls' Camp – This camp fills up fast, and registration is limited, so send in your registration right away! Come enjoy camp without the distractions of boys. Activities are focused on the interests and needs of young girls, mentally, physically, and spiritually. You may come for this camp and stay through the Co-ed Camp. \$100.00

July 20-24 Co-ed Camp – Come share life with a variety of friends as we explore the beauty of our part of the Black Hills, and the sacredness of our lives in God. We will learn more about Jesus and ourselves as we “Go Higher Up, Go Deeper In.” If you register for either the All Boys' Camp or the All Girls' Camp in addition to this one, please pay for both. Again, this is a popular camp, so register early! \$100.00

July 24-28 All Boys' Camp – Just for boys, this camp is becoming very popular, so sign up early to be sure you have a spot. Geared toward the things boys like to do and think about, this camp also stretches the understanding of “guys in church.” You may start at the Co-ed Camp and stay through this one. \$100.00

For All Ages:

July 10-13 Family Camp – Our only requirement to fit the “definition” of family is that an adult accompanies children (anyone under 18), with no more than three children per adult, please. We have had grandparents with grandchildren, college students with younger siblings, groups of adult sisters, parents and their adult children, couples, singles, adult siblings, and aunts or uncles with nieces or nephews. This camp provides some time to explore the attractions of the Black Hills, as well as the spiritual and physical refreshment of the camp program and facility. Camp begins with supper on the 10th, and ends after lunch on the 13th. You may come late or leave early if you cannot take all the time off (but do let us know if you will). This is a great way to spend time together and get to know our staff and facility. Rooms are available in the lodge for participants with special physical needs. \$100.00 for those 12 and over, \$50.00 for children 5-11 years old, children under five years old free.

Day Camps
